## Report of the feedbacks taken from students, teachers, alumni and employer of Asutosh College

The college has taken feedbacks from students, teachers, alumni and employer, on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution as well as other generic activities. Following are the summary of the feedbacks received from the mentioned stakeholders:

Student Feedback: Majority of the students feel that the course curriculum is up to date with present day requirement and well balanced between theory and application. The available infrastructure in the college is sufficient for course curriculum. Most of the students are satisfied with the elective courses offered to them and the syllabus of the courses generates interest to study the subjects in details. According to the students, enough study and reference books are mentioned in the syllabus and also the faculties provide sufficient study materials to them. The project/field works also helps to understand the subject better.

Teachers Feedback: The teachers are very satisfied with the available infrastructure to deliver the course curriculum. They feel that the administration is highly supportive for innovative teaching methods like outreach/extension activities and also offers financial support for organizing any workshop/ seminar etc. Most of the faculties appreciate the support that the college administration gives for research activities and promotion related matters. The majority of the faculties are happy with timely redressal of any grievance registered, though some of them thinks that they are not well aware about this process. The faculties are mostly satisfied with the staff-room and washroom facilities and work culture of the college.

Employer Feedback: The employer of the institution feels that the course curriculum is very much relevant for employability and instigate the students to develop innovative ideas. It is also very effective for overall development of the students including entrepreneurship skills. The employer feels that syllabus of different courses is prepared keeping in mind the new concepts and recent trends in the field of study and inculcates sufficient knowledge for present day job requirement in both Government and corporate world. The employer strongly feels that the employees have
