Admission to 4-Year B.A./ B.Sc. (Honours and Honours with Research) Courses of Studies Under Curriculum and Credit Framework, 2022 Academic Session: 2023-2024

Guidelines for admission to Semester Wise 4-Year B.A./ B.Sc. Degree Programme under [Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF, 2022)] offered by Asutosh College, affiliated to the University of Calcutta.

Applicants are requested to kindly read the eligibility criteria and guidelines shared below carefully before filling up the application form online.

- Undergraduate admissions for 2023-2024 shall be conducted by online mode only through our college website https://asutoshcollege.in
- Applicants must first register through the above portal; the entire procedure for application and admission are strictly online. There is no provision for offline application for admission.
- Online application for UG admission is entirely free of cost. No Application Fee will be charged from the applicants.
- Online Application for admission to 4-year B.A./ B.Sc. courses for the academic year 2023-2024 will open on and from 01.07.2023, Saturday, 11:00 A.M. onwards. Online Application portal shall remain open till 15.07.2023, Saturday 11:59 P.M.
- Applicants are required to apply online within the stipulated time period mentioned above and strictly follow the Admission Schedules and other notifications published in the admission portal regularly.
- Subject-wise Provisional Merit Lists will be published on 17.07.2023, Monday by 12 Noon. Interested candidates must report to "Online Wish List" positively till 18.07.2023, Tuesday by 4
 P.M. for 1st Online Reporting.
- Online admission for 4-year UG courses against 1st Merit List will start on 19.07.2023 Wednesday (10:00 A.M. onwards).
- Please follow the college website for further publication of Merit Lists from time to time.
- Admission Regulation (As per Notification No. CSR/05/2023 Dated 23.06.2023). The details are shared below:
 - (a) A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the B.A./B.Sc. (Single-Major) Course of Studies provided the candidate has also passed in English having full marks not being <u>less than 100</u> and fulfills the conditions as laid down in clause 2, 10 and 12.

However, no student shall be allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

(**Explanation**: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination).

1. (b) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All-India Boards/Councils (i.e., CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) <u>need</u> not require to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

2. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./ (Single-Major) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a student. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

(a) <u>A student taking up Major Course in a subject must have obtained:</u>

i. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

ii. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

 50% marks in the aggregate when the student has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

(b) Students belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Major Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

(c) Seat reservation for admission in the first-year class of four-year (eight semesters) degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014 and Memorandum No. 339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023, dt. 26.05.2023.

- Classes for 1st Semester of all B.A./ B.Sc. for 4-year (Honours and Honours with Research) Courses will commence from 01.08.2023 (Tuesday).
- ✤ Foreign students, with completely published results of 10+2 level or equivalent examinations, are eligible for application.

Procedure of Online Application:

- Eligible candidates must first register themselves on the college admission portal <u>https://asutoshcollege.in</u> and then proceed to online application.
- During the application, all fields mentioned in the application form should be correctly entered after careful consideration. Candidates should revise and preview their application forms before final submission. However, students can change/ edit their data/ information themselves through the admission portal during the application period (till 15.07.2023, Friday (11:59 P.M.).
- Forms will be considered valid only if candidates make successful online submission of application forms and upload their required documents.
- The college is not liable for any erroneous information provided by the candidates. Admission is liable to be cancelled if a candidate is found guilty of suppression or of misrepresentation of materials/ facts at any stage.
- Admission related queries may be sent to <u>admission.2023@asutoshcollege.in</u>
- Candidates must take a print-out of the application form generated after successful online submission and produce the same only at the time of verification or whenever required.
- Applicants are NOT required to physically report to the college campus/ office for submission of documents or for any other reason during the admission process. Candidates will have to physically report to the college only after admission for verification of documents as and when notified by the college authority.
- Candidates will be informed through e-mail and SMS after successful online submission of application. In case of DND settings in applicant's contact number he/she may not receive any SMS. The college shall not be responsible in such cases.
- Successful submission of application does not ensure admission of a candidate. Applicants shall be notified regarding their admission strictly on the basis of the Merit as per the publication of provisional Merit List published in the college portal.

Documents Required for Uploading During Online Application:

Applicants are required to upload self-attested photo copies of original documents (scanned image, .jpeg format only) during the time of application. The required documents are as follows:

- 7. Caste Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB).
- 8. Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB).
- 9. BPL Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB).
- 10. EWS Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB).
- 11. Migration Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB)*
- 12. Equivalence Certificate Document, if applicable (Size 100 KB)*
- 13. Registration Certificate only for candidates already registered under CU (Size 100 KB)

*Required during CU Registration for students from boards other than WB Council of HS Education, ISC and CBSE.

Online Applications shall not be valid unless the above documents are uploaded in the college portal during online application.

Important Information:

- Merit List (provisional) to be published tentatively on 17.07.2023 on the admission portal <u>www.asutoshcollege.in</u> Applicants must follow the said admission portal for publication of detailed Admission Schedules, Call Lists and other Notices.
- Only candidates whose names will be published in the Call Lists will be eligible for admission.
- There will be No Admission Test for admission to any B.A./ B.Sc. course. The Merit List (provisional) will be prepared according to the "Index Marks Formulae" given below.
- After publication of Merit List (provisional) online admission will be conducted through the college portal.
- Admission Schedule(s) for all rounds (as & when applicable) of online admission will be published in the college portal <u>www.asutoshcollege.in</u> from time to time. Online admission to the college will be conducted according to the Admission Schedule(s) and selected candidates are required to follow the same carefully.
- Only candidates whose names appear on the Call Lists can take online admission and pay the admission fee online through this portal.
- For every round of admission there will be separate Call Lists in courses where vacancies are still available and candidates will be given a particular time period for online admission for every round.
 The Call List will become invalid beyond the stipulated date and time.
- ☆ A candidate failing to take online admission during the given period is liable to lose his/ her chance of admission to the college in the selected course. Call List for one round of admission is not valid for other rounds.
- The college shall not be responsible if the candidates fail to follow instructions published on the college admission portal.
- Cancellation: Candidates admitted to a course in this college for the session 2023-2024 will be able to cancel his/ her admission online through the portal. They are required to preserve the cancellation voucher generated during online cancellation for future reference. There is no provision for offline cancellation of admission.
- During the online admission process, a candidate already admitted to a course in this college in an earlier round of admission, can shift to another course of the candidate's choice during a later round of admission, provided his/ her name appears in the respective Call List valid for the said later round. In such cases, the candidate must cancel his/ her previous admission online before proceeding to take admission to the course of his/ her choice. A candidate cannot occupy more than one seat at the same time in the college.
- If a candidate decides to get admitted to any other institution after admission to a course in Asutosh College, the said candidate should immediately cancel his/ her seat in this college. Candidates are requested to refrain from unnecessary blocking of seats for the sake of good order.
- ✤ It must be noted that if a candidate cancels his/ her admission to a particular course, he/ she cannot claim seat in that course later.

- All online admission is provisional and is subject to verification of relevant documents. The college reserves its rights to cancel a candidate's admission if the documents are not found in conformity with the declarations made by the applicant in the form submitted online.
- Asutosh College reserves its rights to modify and amend published notices and schedules regarding admission. Applicants are required to comply accordingly.
- Admission to the college is granted on the understanding that the student undertakes to conform to the rules and codes of conduct of Asutosh College and the University of Calcutta.
- Registration under "WISH-LIST": The College has kept a provision for candidates to register their willingness for admission to Asutosh College though registering under "Wish-List". The link for the Wish-List Registration will be made available on the college admission portal in due course of time. Only applicants whose names have appeared in the Merit List (provisional) will be able to register under "Wish-List". Applicants are instructed to follow the admission portal for Admission Schedule and all subsequent notices and register their names under the Wish List without fail whenever notified.
- Registration of Students under the University of Calcutta: Students' Registration under the University of Calcutta will be initiated after completion of the online admission process. Candidates admitted to Asutosh College will be intimated about the procedure of Registration through further notification published on the admission portal. Candidates will have to follow the instructions accordingly.
- Hostel Accommodation: Outstation applicants may apply for accommodation in the hostel of Asutosh College. For the above, applicants are required to tick the hostel option on each application form during online application and thus register their names for enjoying Hostel Facility.
- Hostel seats are limited and admission to the college does not ensure hostel accommodation. Hostel seat is granted on the basis of merit as well as the distance of the applicant's place of residence from the college campus. However, after completion of the admission process a candidate in need of hostel accommodation may appeal to the college authorities for a seat which may be considered on availability of vacancy in hostel.
- Notification regarding Hostel Admission will be issued to the admitted students who are eligible for hostel accommodation. The candidates will have to report to the campus for Hostel Admission and pay required hostel fees at the time of occupancy of hostel seats.

In-take capacity and Reservation:

The number of seats approved for 4-year B.A. /B.Sc. (Honours and Honours with Research) courses offered by the college is given below. Admission will be conducted as per available vacancies in various categories. Reservation Policy for admission shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act 2013 and Rules, 2014 and Memorandum No.330-Edn(CS)/OM-74L/2023, dt., 26.05.2023. For Persons with Disabilities (PwD), reservation will be maintained as per the relevant norms (5% of seats are reserved in each category vide G.O.No.1084(20)-Edn(U)/EH/1U-89/13 dated 07.12.18 of Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal).

4-Year B.A. & B.Sc. Courses (Honours and Honours with Research) as per University of Calcutta, Notification No. CSR/05/2023 Dated 23.06.2023

(a) A student taking up Major Course in a subject must have obtained:

i. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

Or

ii. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

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ii. 50% marks in the aggregate when the student has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

(b) Students belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Major Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

12. A student shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading "A" if the candidate had passed the subject(s) under heading "B" at the previous qualifying examination

13. Some Special conditions for taking up Major Courses as follows:

(i) <u>Economics</u>: A Student shall be allowed to take up Major in Economics if the candidate has passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of H.S. Education or its equivalent examination in Mathematics/ Business Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics. Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S.(10+2) level from West Bengal Council of H.S. Education are also eligible for admission with Economics as the Major subject, students of Economics Major have to take up Mathematics as one of the Minor subject.

(ii) <u>Mathematics</u>: A student shall be allowed to take up Major in Mathematics if the candidate has passed in Mathematics/ Applied Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination. A student who has passed in Business Mathematics is not eligible for admission to the Mathematics Major Course.

(iii) <u>Chemistry</u>: A student shall be allowed to take-up Major in Chemistry if the candidate has passed in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination.

(iv) <u>Bio-Chemistry</u>: A student shall be allowed to take up Major in Bio-Chemistry if the candidate has passed in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology/Bio-Technology at the previous qualifying examination.

* A student of B.Sc. (Major) in Bio-Chemistry shall have to take-up elective subjects as stated hereunder and inconformity with Grouping of Subjects:

(a) Any one of the subjects: Physics/Mathematics/Statistics

and

(b) Any one of the subjects: Zoology/ Botany/ Microbiology/ Physiology/ Molecular-Biology.

(v) <u>Micro-Biology</u>: A student shall be allowed to take-up Major in Micro Biology if the candidate has passed in Chemistry in the previous qualifying Examination.

*Subject combination for Micro-Biology: Chemistry and any one of the following subjects:

Mathematics/Physics/Computer Science/Botany/Zoology/Physiology.

(vi) <u>Physiology</u>: A student shall be allowed to take-up Major in Physiology if the candidate has passed the subject Physiology/Biology/Bio-Technology and Chemistry in the previous qualifying Examination. The subject Biology/Bio-Technology may be treated as the related subject.

(vii) <u>Food and Nutrition</u>: A student shall be allowed to take-up Major in Food and Nutrition if the candidate has passed in Chemistry at the previous qualifying examination and to take up Chemistry as one of the Minor subjects.

(viii) <u>Anthropology</u>: A students shall not be allowed to take-up Anthropology (Major) along with Sociology.

(ix) Environmental Science: Students have to take up Chemistry as one of the Minor subjects.

(x) <u>Computer Science</u>: The combination of subject for **Computer Science Major** Course shall be **Mathematics** as one of the Minor subjects and any one of the subjects: **either Physics or Statistics or Electronics** as the other Minor subject.

(xi) <u>Education</u>: If the student has not studied Education as a subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/ Philosophy/ Mathematics/Sociology/ Economics/ Political Science/ History /Statistics /Physics /Chemistry /Biology be treated as related subjects.

(xii) <u>Philosophy</u>: If the students has not studied Philosophy as a subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/ Math/ Education/ Sociology/Political Science be treated as related subjects

(xii) **Sociology:** Students passed the previous qualifying examination (10+2) in Science/Humanities/Arts (except Commerce) stream with any subject will be allowed to get admission in Sociology-Major.
