Article 1

OBJECTIVE OF COLLABORATION

- e. Sharing of scientific information on areas of mutual interest.
- f. Sharing of resources (laboratory facility) through exchange programs
- g. Undertaking Joint Research Program, if possible, in form of collaborative research for social
- h. Academic quality-based collaboration in form of publications and internships.
- i. Framing short term technical training courses (industry ready) on field instruments and lab
- Participation in project works, if any

Article 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

Involvement of funds, if required under this Memorandum of Understanding, will be subjected to approval of relevant authority/authorities.

Article 4

LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

- 1. The Parties agree to implement the programs stated in Article 2 at Asutosh College and Sea Explorers' Institute.
- 2. Any changes of the location of the programs shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

Article 5

MODE OF CONDUCTING THE PROGRAMMES

The programs will be conducted in blended mode (offline and online). Both parties will be at liberty to enter into similar agreements with other academic/ non-academic institutions and no notification for this will be binding on any of them.

Article 6

CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) PROTECTION

Both the institutions shall respect and retain confidentially in each/ any of the collaborative efforts, and all collaborative academic exercises shall be guided, directed and impelled by the greater academic interest of both the institutions, and not any other / commercial interest.

This MOU will respect Intellectual Property Rights and any intellectual matter developed by the collaborative efforts of two institutions shall be retained by them.

Article 7

DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five (5) years by the mutual written consent of the Parties.
- 3. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notice to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, at least six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- 4. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any project/s and program/s in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

Article 8

AMENDMENT

- 1. This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- 2. Such amendment/s or revision/s shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

Article 9 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between the Parties.
