

- 6.2. Oral and/or implied termination will neither be effected, nor alleged at any point of time by any of the incumbent college under any circumstances whatsoever.





The proceedings before the Arbitrator shall be in English.
- 7.3. The sole Arbitrator to be nominated by the parties under this agreement shall be an Indian national and a qualified working/retired professor/assistant professor of Software Development (SD) or Department of Banking, Financial Services and Insurance (BFSI) of any college (other than the incumbent colleges) affiliated to any state/national university having his place of residence in the city of Kolkata. Persons having previous experience of adjudication of disputes arising under similar agreements shall be given preference while selecting an Arbitrator.
- 7.4. The laws of India shall be followed while adjudicating the disputes under this understanding.
- 7.5. The venue of the Arbitration shall be within the limits of the city of Kolkata.
- 7.6. The parties hereby choose the jurisdiction of the City Civil Court, Kolkata, for all legal purpose.
