BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT:

Dengue is a viral disease transmitted to human by the bite of infected *Aedes* mosquito. Mosquito breeds in areas having even a small quantity of water, generally stagnant water. If bitten by infected mosquito, symptoms like fever, fatigue, vomiting sensation, Joint pain, and muscle pain. Even death is possible. Like previous years, Asutosh College has taken the initiatives of organizing the Awareness program in all the college campuses, near college surrounding areas etc. On 22th September, 2022 NSS unit comprising of NSS coordinator, other members including faculties and students of the college has visited Patuapara slum area, Bhawanipore, Kolkata for spreading Dengue awareness program by talking to the residents, spreading bleaching powder in the garbage area, places with stagnant water etc. Procession from Main building to Patuapara is conducted by NSS volunteers and teachers as part of the awareness program on 22th September, 2022. Our members have done their job by spreading bleaching powder, cleaning, discussion etc. Our NSS coordinator Dr. Ashis Kumar Das has talked with the residents there to advise, suggest them to not allow water to remain stagnant near their house, to clean the blocked drains, tray below the fridge also to be cleaned

regularly, also to dispose of old containers, mug, buckets, tyres etc, to keep the water tanks and water containers covered so that the mosquitoes cannot enter there and start breeding. Also the importance of cleaning the surroundings of a house is discussed. We also asked whether they use mosquito nets or not as part of the program. The program is completed by sprinkling bleaching powder in the college premises followed by a short lecture given by the NSS coordinator Dr. Asish Kumar Das.

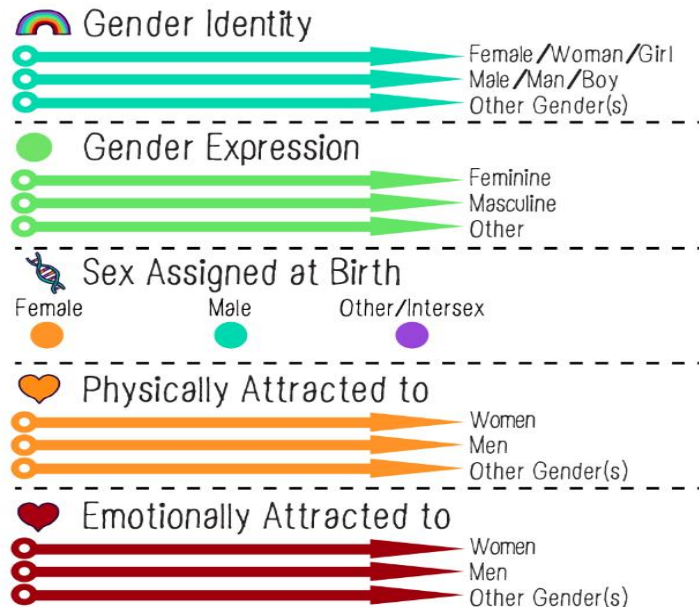

BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT:

The NSS Unit of Asutosh college, Women Empowerment Cell of Asutosh College and IQAC Asutosh College was organized a one-day workshop-cum-seminar titled "**GENDER SENSITIZATION**" on 23th February , 2023 Seminar Hall in Centenary Building . The main speaker of the seminar was Dr. Rhiddhi Saha, Assistant Professor of Asutosh College, Dept. of communicative English. Dr. Sanchita Sanyal was another Speaker of this Seminar. IQAC coordinator Dr. Sriparna Datta Roy, Teacher Councils Secretary Dr. Rina kar (Datta) and Students from various departments of Asutosh College were present in the programme. About 50 students actively participated in this Seminar. In a free-flowing discussion facilitated by the faculty members, students shared their experiences with some very bold and outspoken acknowledgements of their identity. Social labelling as man or woman was criticised by some of the students present who openly identified themselves as part of the LGBTQ community, while some spoke about their sexual orientations, which a hetero-normative society marks as 'deviant' or 'abnormal.' The right to choose partners as per one's sexual orientation was demanded by some. Short clippings of the Bell Baja campaign to break the cycle of domestic violence were screened. Dr. Rhiddhi Saha interacted with the students and pointed out that education coupled with awareness generation and sensitization programmes at all levels would bring about a change in the mind set.

Expected outcome: You're not a lawmaker. But you are a citizen. So as citizens, if we join hands together to understand be more sensitive to gender, try to ensure equality across genders, be aware of laws that can help prevent oppression, and push for better reforms in our laws, only then we could become gender sensitized as a country.
