Matri Mossion 'O' Mandir is a sanyashi concern established in 2000 in Kalyani town. The organization is involved in various social activities in addition to religious activities. This organization maintains a small dairy farm located in Saheb Bagan, Kalyani, Nadia. The organization reached us through the head of the institute to visit their farm for consultancy. The general requirement was to check the altered male female sex ratio of cows and other avenues to improve the overall health condition of the cows and their livelihood.

We reached the farm on morning of 22 March 2022. The goshala is housing 21 adult cows of which two are male and the 19 female. The cleanliness and hygiene of the farm is satisfactory. Calves are kept separately in an open enclosure.

Brief recommendations given by us-

If the organization wants only female calf, use of sex sorted seeds is recommended.

Cows should be allowed to roam freely at least two hours a day, to minimize their captivity life and self infliction.

New cows may be introduced.

Measures should be taken for regular check up of the animals by a qualified vet and take proper corrective and preventive actions.
