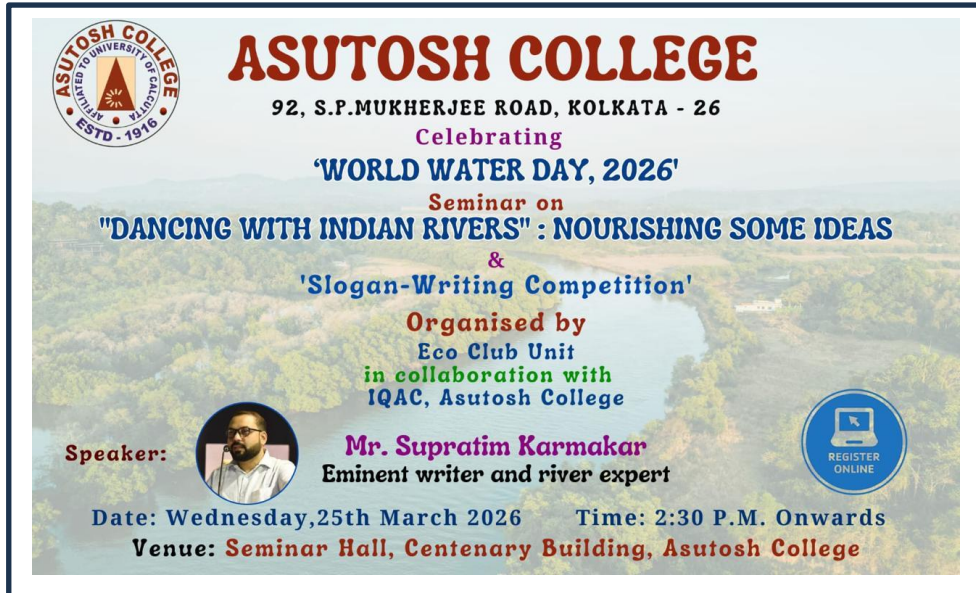

2nd -Kriti Subba, UG 1st Sem, Department of Environmental Science

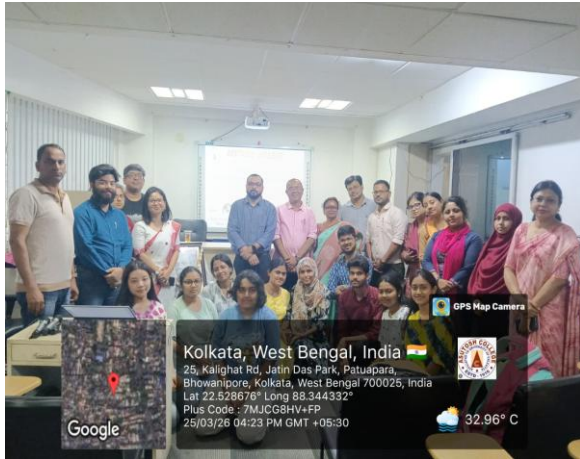
3rd -Ahana Bhattacharya, UG 1st Sem, Department of Environmental Science.
