
Title of the event: "Employment Challenges in India: A brief Outlook"


Title of the event: "ASPECTS OF INDIAN ECONOMY"

Outcome: This interactive session certainly enhanced the knowledge level of the students with respect to the topic and also motivated them to engage themselves in more such sessions.




EVENT : EDUCATIONAL TRIP: Reserve Bank of India museum visit




















EVENT: Visit to THE NATIONAL LIBRARY
