- **BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT/ PROGRAMME:** The house built by the father of the Indian nationalist Subhas Chandra Bose in Kolkata is today known as Netaji Bhawan. There is a museum, an archive and a library to satisfy the queries of minds interested in the history of the country's freedom movement and Netaji's role in it. It is maintained by the Netaji Research Bureau. The students were taken to visit this institution to learn about a person like Netaji who often stood alone against the oppressive British Raj in the Indian freedom struggle.
The Asutosh Mookerjee Memorial Institute is named after Sir Asutosh Mookerjee, the founder of our college, a great educationist, and another nation-builder. It houses a museum and a library for academic purposes. Sir Asutosh was popularly known as the 'Tiger of Bengal' for his courage, intensity of passion and practice of integrity.
- **EXPECTED OUTCOME:** Students would develop a research mindset, and be motivated towards noble works of life sacrificing the limited interests.

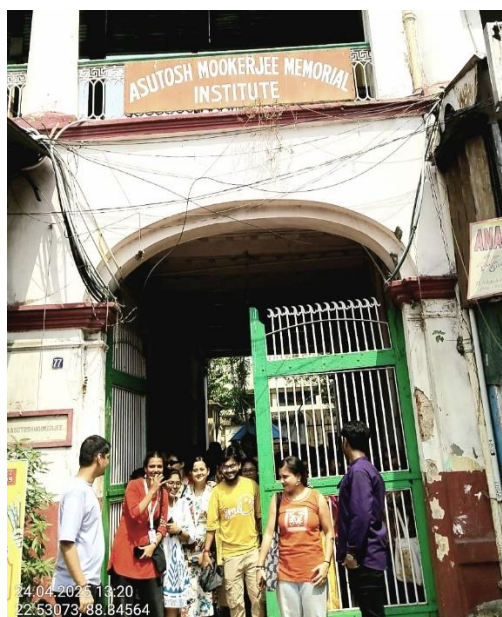
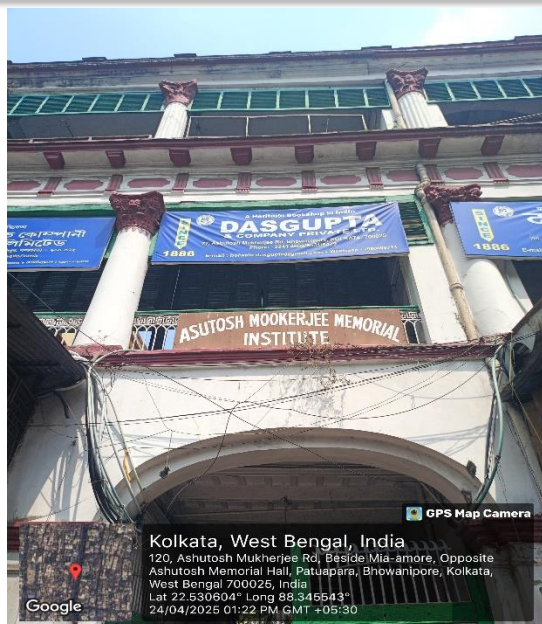
