## ➤ BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT:

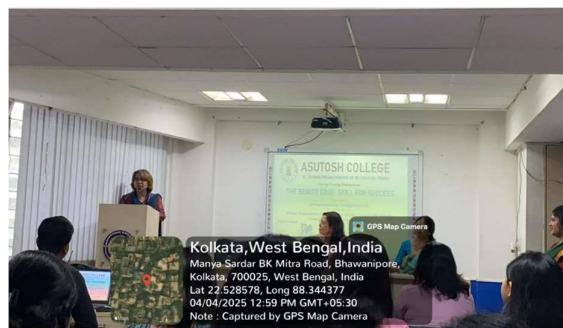
