
TITLE OF EVENT: Book Launch

BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT:

The event presided by Prof. Tathagata Roy Chowdhury, Department of Botany, Asutosh College initiated by the welcome note. Importance of new industry-oriented job perspective, the inter-personal relationship skills and the pathway to remain important and profitable (and thus hiriable) in an industrial setup, as well as the role of being a successful enterpreneur were highlighted. The invited speaker, who was an alumnus of the Department's 2001 Batch and batchmate of Prof. Surjya Sarathi Bhattacharyya was introduced to the audience by Prof. Amit Kumar Bhattacharjee. The event was anchored and the Vote of Thanks were also delivered by Prof. Amit Kumar Bhattacharjee. Around **75** students of the Physics Department participated in the event. The program initiated via a direct student-speaker interaction about career and pathway beyond the domain of Physics. The main take home message was to identify few human qualities and traits using which a person can remain useful between product (and team workers delivering the same) and client to become a very successful enterpreneur. An example from the Pharmaceutical world were demonstrated as an example. We expect such phenomenal international exposure of alumnus from industry who had been working as a successful interpreneur may help shape the future of many students, who wish

to explore such opportunities at an International platform in the challenging World of today, where academic jobs as well as Government funded jobs are way too limited.

EXPECTED OUTCOME:

The event "Physics & Beyond: Give Your Learning a Wing" aimed to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world application, particularly emphasizing entrepreneurship in the field of physics. By bringing in an accomplished alumnus like Mr. Arnab Chakraborty, the event provided students with valuable insights into how their physics education could translate into successful entrepreneurial ventures, especially in industries beyond academia. The interactive session facilitated direct engagement between students and the speaker, fostering a deeper understanding of the skills and qualities necessary for success in the professional world.
