

## Student's Participation in LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) Program of Government of India conducted by West Bengal Pollution Control Board on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2023

West Bengal Pollution Control Board had organized a program to observe International day of clean air for Blue Skies on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 at the Auditorium, Paribesh Bhawan, Bidhanagar, Kolkata. The objective was to create awareness at all level with large scale public participation in order to improve the air quality for a better and healthy air to breathe.

Since 2020 the West Bengal Pollution Control Board has been observing the International day of Clean Air for Blue Skies as part of the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) launched by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India in January, 2019 for the improvement of Ambient Air Quality in 131 non-attainment cities including six cities in West Bengal.
