Objectives:

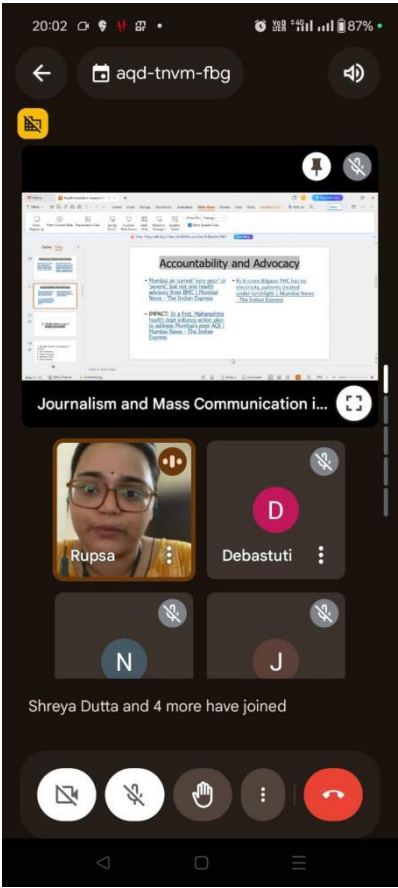
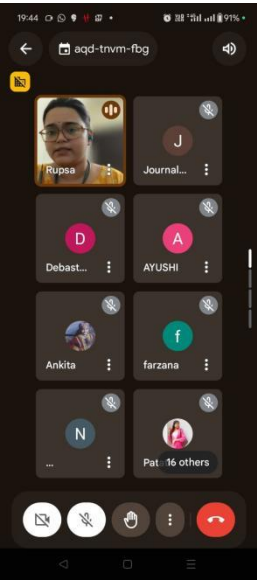
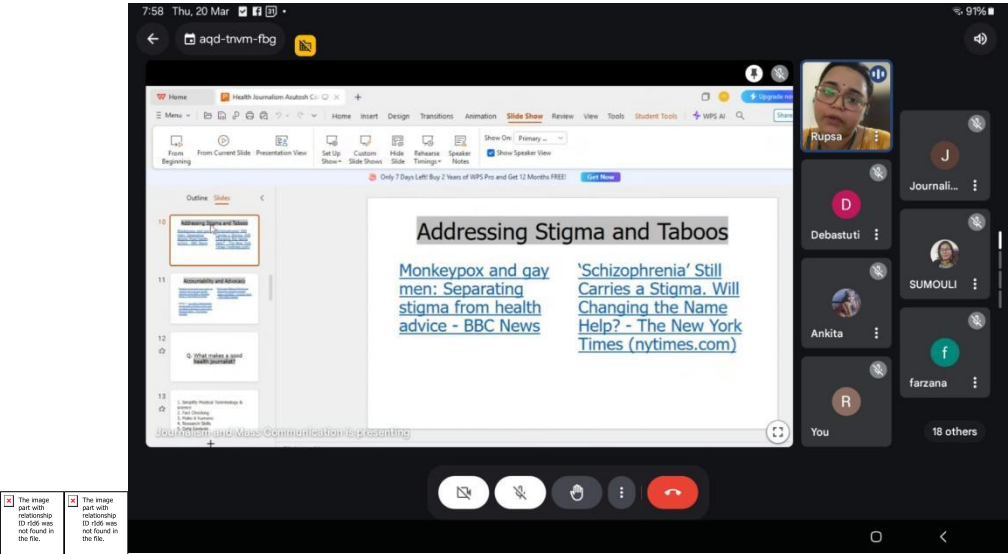
1. To address the challenges and opportunities for journalism students in the field of Health Journalism.
