On the 1st of December 2022, Dr. Moon Jana, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Asutosh College delivered a lecture titled "Community Radio: Reaching the Voiceless." The lecture was attended by students and faculty members of Asutosh College who were keen on comprehending the concept of community radio and its impact on society.
