- At the beginning of the 2023-2024 academic year, eligible students were informed about the Kanyashree Prakalpa initiative through multiple channels, including posters, SMS notifications, and official notices.

- Two students qualified for the K-1 grant.
- Till date, 142 students (119 Upgraded K2+ 23 Fresh K2) have successfully qualified for the K-2 grant.
