## ➤ BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT:

The Department of Mathematics, Asutosh College organized an Experiential Learning Excursion at Alipore Museum on 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 to enrich the learning experience of students.

The students and teachers of the Department of Mathematics of Asutosh College visited the Alipore Museum on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, near 7 Judges Court Road, Alipore, Kolkata, West Bengal 700027, for an experiential learning excursion. The Alipore Central Correctional Home is a national historic landmark located in the heart of Kolkata. This 116 year old building, along with the Presidency Jail, is on the Grade I list of heritage sites of Kolkata. Constructed in 1906, and spread over 15.2 acres, this colonial era institution abuts Tolly's Nullah and can be identified easily with its characteristic brick-red walls. Within the premises one can spot the Alipore Jail Press Building, the central watchtower, over a dozen buildings which served as prison cells and wards, and the Alipore Jail Hospital building. Notable freedom fighters who were incarcerated here include Jawaharlal Nehru, Subhash Chandra Bose, Chittaranjan Das, Dinesh Gupta, Dr Bidhan Chandra Roy to name a few. It served as a correctional home till 2019 when the inmates were shifted to Baruipur, on the outskirts of Kolkata. From being a silent witness to the brutalities inflicted on the freedom fighters of the country, the Alipore Central Correctional Home is now transformed as a memorial and museum to honour the sacrifice of those who fought for the independence of India. It serves as a testament to innovation, enriching lives and contributing to scientific advancement.

At first the students toured the museum and witnessed India's freedom struggle during the British period. The museum has display of paintings, photographs, maps of India during the various

periods of History, installations, and statues of the freedom fighters. Other than it has the letters and other documents and artifacts related to the freedom struggle. The students then visited the Gallows area which is a place decorated with the names of great freedom fighters, who were hanged in the Alipore Central Correctional Home. The students also visited the Hospital Building. This building has been chosen by the Architect as the main exhibition building. This building have souvenir room, INA theme cafe', exhibits of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose in the ground floor and exhibits related to Rishi Aurobindo, Dinesh Gupta, Women Martyrs of Bengal and the history of 18th & 19th Century starting from Battle of Plassey in Bengal (1757) upto the freedom movement of 1947 in the 1st floor of the building.

After moving around the museum the students were very happy. Then some snacks were distributed to the students. The students were very satisfied to have this kind of educational excursion experience. All the activities were done in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college. Few pictures of the event are attached below. In the future, the department will be interested in taking students to such educational trips.
