

National Institute of Technical Teachers' Training and Research (NITTTR), Kolkata under the Ministry of Education (MOE) Govt. of India.

The seminar started with a welcome address by the head of the department Dr. Prabir Rudra. After that Mr. Ashim Sarkar gave a small introduction of the speaker. The talk started at 2 P.M. The speaker used ICT tools like powerpoint presentations while giving his lecture.

Python Programming is a crucial component of undergraduate mathematics education. Python languages can be used in developmental projects. It can speed up the project creation times because python language is easy to read and use. Python programs are like text files containing
