REPORT ON MOVEMENT MEDITATION WORKSHOP

Date: 6th March, 2024

Report: On the 6th of March, 2024, the Psychotherapy Unit, Department of Psychology, Asutosh College, and Staff Welfare Committee, and association with IQAC, Asutosh College organised a workshop on Movement Meditation for all faculty members. The resource person for this workshop was Smt. Nandini Choudhury, MediNDI and Crystal Minds, Kolkata.

The session commenced with a welcome address which was followed by felicitation of Smt. Choudhury. This was followed by a few words of inspiration and encouragement by Prof. Dr. Manas Kabi, Principal, Asutosh College, for the enthusiastic participation in the session.

Smt. Choudhury then began the workshop by offering a brief introduction about what movement meditation is and what the session would entail. She also briefly touched upon breathing exercises, and breath meditation, and clarified the distinctions between the two.

Smt. Choudhury then demonstrated and guided the participants in mindful breath meditation. This was eventually followed by a period of movement meditation in which participants moved around the room to the best of music and were encouraged to interact with each other as their paths crossed. After this, a second round of movement meditation followed in which some of the participants were blindfolded while the

rest were not. This was done to encourage building of trust and encourage spontaneity and fluidity of movements.

A short refreshment break was then provided following which the session resumed with participants engaging in further movement meditation in time with the beats of energetic drum beats. Under the capable guidance provided by Smt. Choudhury, the participants were able to shed their initial reserve and mindfully engage in movement meditation.

Lastly, the participants engaged in another span of breath mediation followed by a spontaneous session of movement meditation to the beat of drums. The resource person then invited the participants to share their insights from the session and put forward any queries to her in an interactive session.

The workshop saw enthusiastic participation from faculty members across a multitude of departments who were keen to learn more about movement meditation. The event concluded with a closing address by the principal who commended the efforts of Smt. Choudhury in conducting such an invigorating session on movement meditation.
