

After the pandemic-enforced hiatus, the Publication Cell renewed its activities from January 2022, with a series of publication initiatives:

- **STUDENTS' WEEK CELEBRATION REPORT**

The first week of January in 2022 was celebrated in educational institutions across the state as 'Students' Week' following government instructions. The Publication Cell's inaugural venture for 2022 was to compile and publish a report of the event as it was celebrated in our college in association with the Asutosh College Students' Union and the IQAC.

- A brace of publications followed in April, 2022 –

THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC: FACING THE CHALLENGE, a comprehensive report of all academic/curricular, co-curricular, and social outreach activities engaged in by both students and members of staff as well as two research-oriented articles by some members of the teaching staff. The volume was dedicated to the memory of three bright young colleagues who were snatched away untimely by the Covid-19 disease – Dr Pooja Chatterjee (Dept. of Psychology), Dr Nandan Ghosh (Dept. of Mathematics), and Dr Dilruba Khatun (Dept. of Economics).

VISTA: A HANDBOOK OF JOB-ORIENTED CERTIFICATE COURSES, a compilation of the different job-oriented Certificate Courses offered by the college to all its students.

Both these were our first ISBN publications.

- In July, 2022, **SHE EMPOWERED**, an anthology of articles written mostly by members of the teaching staff of our college and one by a guest contributor was published.

This third ISBN publication was in collaboration with the Women Empowerment Cell of Asutosh College.

- *Smarane Barane Vidyasagar* (Bangla), a compilation of articles on Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar commemorating his 200th Birth Anniversary (1820 – 2020), was also published in collaboration with the Department of Bengali.

The Publication Cell also collaborates in the publication of *The Centurion*, the annual journal of the Asutosh College Teachers' Council.

The College Prospectus is also another annual publication of the Cell.
