Title of the event: National Webinar on: The role of juvenile hormone in reproduction of dengue vector mosquito *Aedes agepti*

Summary of the event:

The Department of Biochemistry organized a one-day National Webinar on The role of juvenile hormone in reproduction of dengue vector mosquito Aedes agepti. The speaker of the day was Dr. Tusar T. Saha, an eminent Molecular Biologist. He is presently working as an Assistant Professor in the Biological Sciences Division of Birla Institute of Science and Technology, Pilani K.K. Goa Campus. He enlightened the present students of the department with his contribution in researches in Biological Sciences. He discussed very passionately about the role of juvenile hormone in the Dengue-causing vector mosquito Aedes agepti and emphasized on the fact that without this hormone the vector fails to grow in the host's body. Therefore, this is an important drugtarget. He described vividly the various molecular biological techniques he had used in his research work. He further added the present loopholes in this field and how those can be approached scientifically with an aim to develop vaccines against dengue. He also discussed about his present ongoing projects and collaborators in this field. He encouraged the students to be passionate about science and research and assured them that he would help them in future venture if needed.

Benefits/outcome of the initiative for the students:

The sole purpose of conducting the webinar lectures in the Department of Biochemistry is to encourage the present students to develop meaningful ambitions in the subject areas. The webinar lecture gave an idea to the students about the research work and the new developing techniques in the field of vector biology. This was an opportunity for the students to interact with the scientist from the similar background as theirs and to clarify their queries regarding their future goals. This interactive and encouraging seminar was very much helpful for the students as this helped them to develop visions about the research work that can be done after graduation in the subject. This also helped to develop connections for the students to apply in the scientist's laboratory in future.

Summary of the Programme:

Semester III and V students delivered presentation on the topic "Contribution of Indian Microbiologists in the field of Bio Sciences". The main highlights were concerning studies and investigations done by eminent scientists as Prof. Hargovind Khorana for deciphering the genetic code which fetched him Noble Prize in 1968, Prof. G N Ramachandran for his famous Ramachandran plot for structural elucidation of proteins, Dr. Nagraj, Dr. Vakil, etc. Even the famous research paper of Prof. AnandaMohan Chakrabarty, and his first patenting of a living organism- *Pseudomonas putida* took place among discussion by the students. The famous incidence of American judicial trial between Mrs. Diamond and Prof. AnandaMohan Chakrabarty known as "Diamond vs Chakrabarty Case" was one of the important topic of discussion among students. Moreover, the students emphasized on the pivotal role taken by different Indian institutes towards research on Covid 19 and corona virus, as well as "COVAXIN" discovery and development by Bharat Biotec in Hyderabad.

The competition had revealed in students; increased research awareness and enthusiasm, improvement of professional presentation and self-evaluation skills, and promotion of active learning and collaboration with peers and professors. The competition had nurtured young minds and inculcated zeal of research idea and innovativeness among students.
