



The lecture is delivered by the eminent Geomorphologist, Prof. Ramkrishna Maiti of Department of Geography and Environment Management of Vidyasagar University, Midnapore, West Bengal. The lecture was organized dated on 9th March, 2022 in YouTube live streaming mode through the official YouTube channel of Asutosh College, Kolkata.

The lecture was focussed on the fundamental key concepts of Geomorphology, but the speaker added a new flavour in it by adding the field-based case studies to establish his view-point. It was quite innovative deliberation which can be understood by the number of viewers.

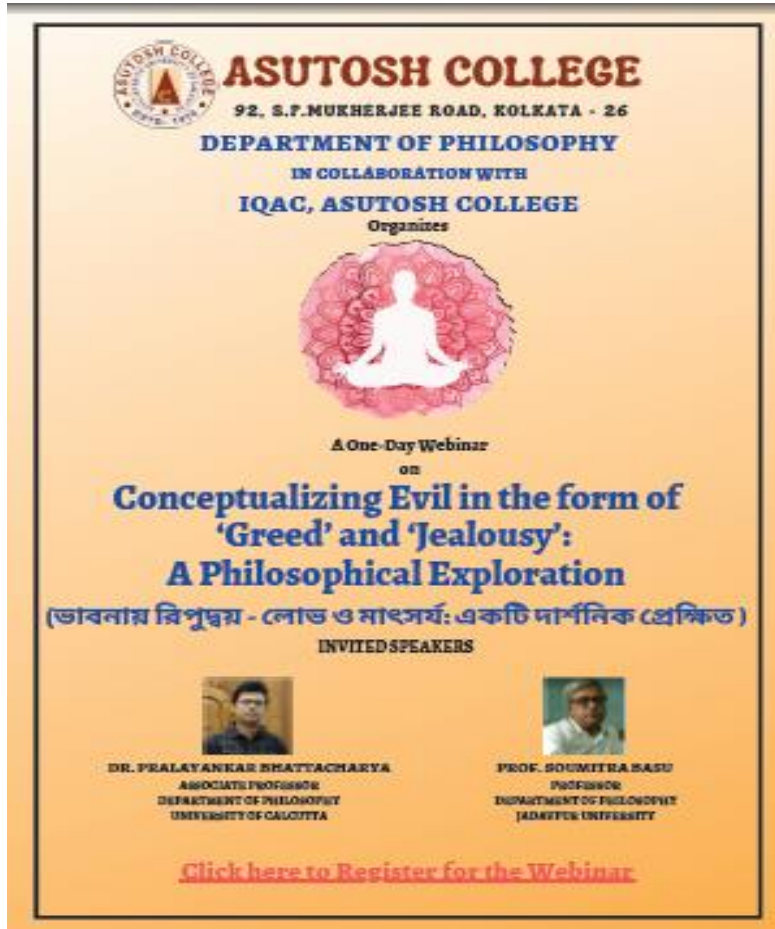
Prof. Maiti gave emphasis on the scale dependency in form-process relationship in different geomorphological environment, especially in fluvial domain in his lecture. Stress was given on the sculpture of landscape as a self-regulatory system. Prof. Maiti is such a pioneer Geomorphologist dealing with the miniature nature-based model study in Geomorphology in actual as well as modified partially controlled environment. He shared his expertise in this field by showing a number of case studies in riverine environments.

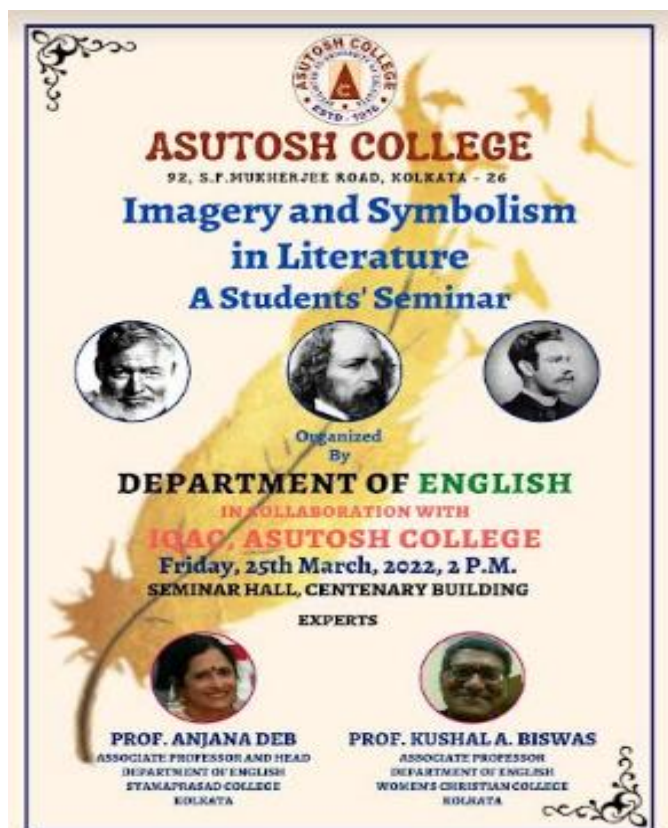
**Department of ENVS Continued**
