Phil. both from the University of Delhi. He is a Ph. D in Statistical Graphics from Gauhati University and was awarded Doctoral Fellowship from ICSSR, New Delhi. His current field of research interest is on data mining in sports, cricket analytics and statistical graphics. He invented a methodology to quantify the fielding performance of cricketers and an App for predicting the outcome of cricket matches.
