- **OBJECTIVE/ PURPOSE:** Objective of this initiative is to safeguard frontline workers such as police personnel and street vendors from the risks of dehydration during peak summer months by distributing Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS) and raising awareness about heat stroke prevention.

- **BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT/ PROGRAMME:** With rising temperatures and prolonged exposure to the sun, individuals working outdoors—especially traffic police and street vendors—are highly vulnerable to heat exhaustion and dehydration. To address this public health concern, our team initiated a campaign to distribute ORS and educate recipients about the importance of staying hydrated. Locations covered: Hazra Crossing, Kalighat Fire Station, Harish Mukherjee Road, 23 Pally Durga Temple and adjacent areas.
- **EXPECTED OUTCOME:** The primary expected outcome of this initiative is improved Awareness on Hydration and Heat Safety. Recipients of the ORS—such as police personnel and street vendors—will be more informed about the importance of staying hydrated during extreme heat conditions. Moreover, our student volunteers will develop a stronger sense of civic responsibility and empathy through direct community service. The program highlights the institution's commitment to promoting public health and safety beyond the campus.
