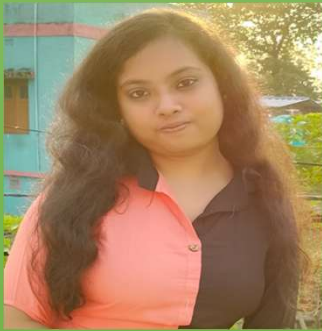


Secret Life of Trees
