Raja Ram Mohan Roy was called a "Bharatpathik" by Rabindranath Tagore for his great achievements. As a result, Ram Mohan Roy's contributions to social reform, women's rights, and education in India and around the world are still relevant in the twenty-first century. 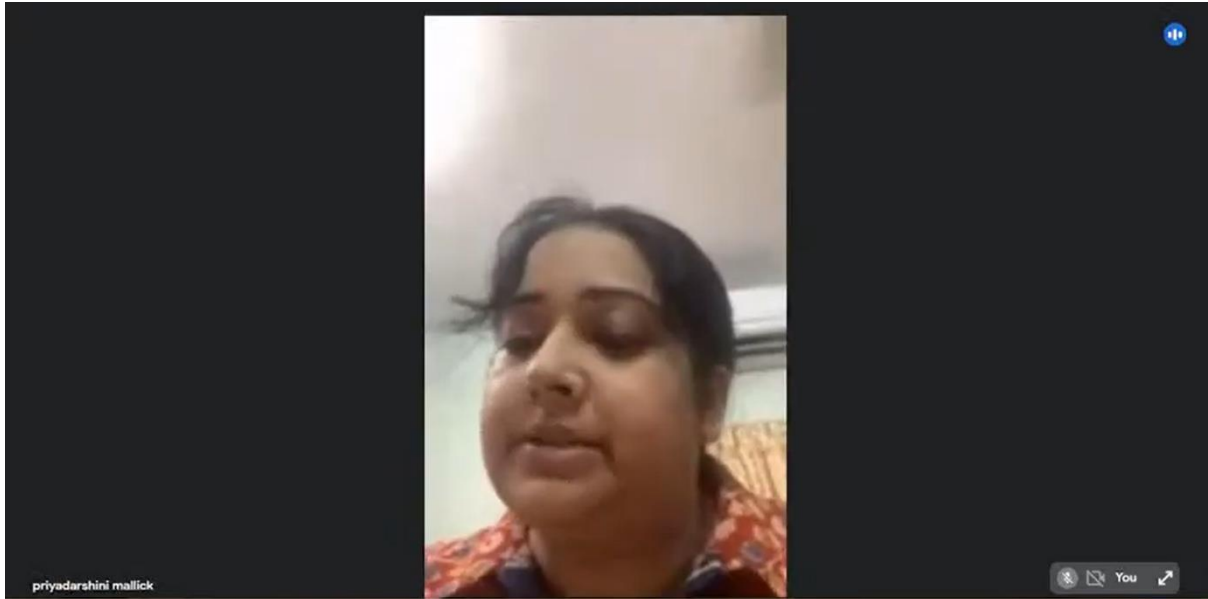
