- **BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE EVENT/ PROGRAMME:**

The committee for Skill Enhancement Programmes in association with IQAC, Asutosh College organized an inaugural ceremony for its Online Skill Enhancement Programmes, catering to Teaching Staff, Non-Teaching Staff, and Students. Dr. Bidisha Dutta Roy initiated the event, inviting Principal Dr. Manas Kabi to welcome the audience. Dr. Kabi introduced three courses: Professional Development for Teaching Staff, Administrative Training for Non-Teaching Staff, and ICT for students. He encouraged participation, announcing an initial intake of around 100 participants per group, with plans for subsequent rounds to accommodate all interested learners. The courses, spanning 30 hours for students and non-teaching staff, and 36 hours for teaching staff, aimed at holistic development.

Sri Bhaskar Mridha and Dr. Sayani Mukhopadhyay from the Governing Body motivated students and staff to leverage the courses for technological empowerment. The Principal officially opened the courses, followed by speakers Prof. Udayan Bhattacharya, Prof. Ranjan Samanta, and Dr. Swapan Khan, who emphasized the need for digitally-oriented pedagogy, comprehensive training, and practical learning.

Prof. Samanta detailed course components, including plagiarism and database usage, and highlighted the involvement of 20 resource persons. The Principal envisaged a future of e-governance, technologically-aided pedagogy, and paperless operations. The event concluded with a vote of thanks from Smt. Shikhi Chatterjee, expressing gratitude for the successful launch of the Skill Enhancement Programmes.
