Dr. Sajal Bhattacharya suggested to conduct a research based survey to observe the implications of the campaign among students by preparing a questionnaire on the life of Sir Asutosh Mukherjee before and after this campaign to observe how this campaign help the students to enhance their knowledge about Sir Asutosh Mukherjee. It can be done by any statistical or mathematical tool after acquiring and analysing the data. Every member present in the meeting has highly accepted and appreciated this idea. However due to the lack of time it may not be possible to implement this in action for this time, but definitely the committee will try to implement this in future time whenever possible.
- 4. It is announced that a one-day seminar on Sir Asutosh Mukherjee will be organised by the committee on 17.11.2022 in the Centenary building with around 50 participants. One external speaker may be invited in the Seminar to deliver speech on Sir Asutosh Mukherjee. Dr. Sanchita Sanyal will deliver a speech in this seminar on Sir Asutosh Mukherjee.
