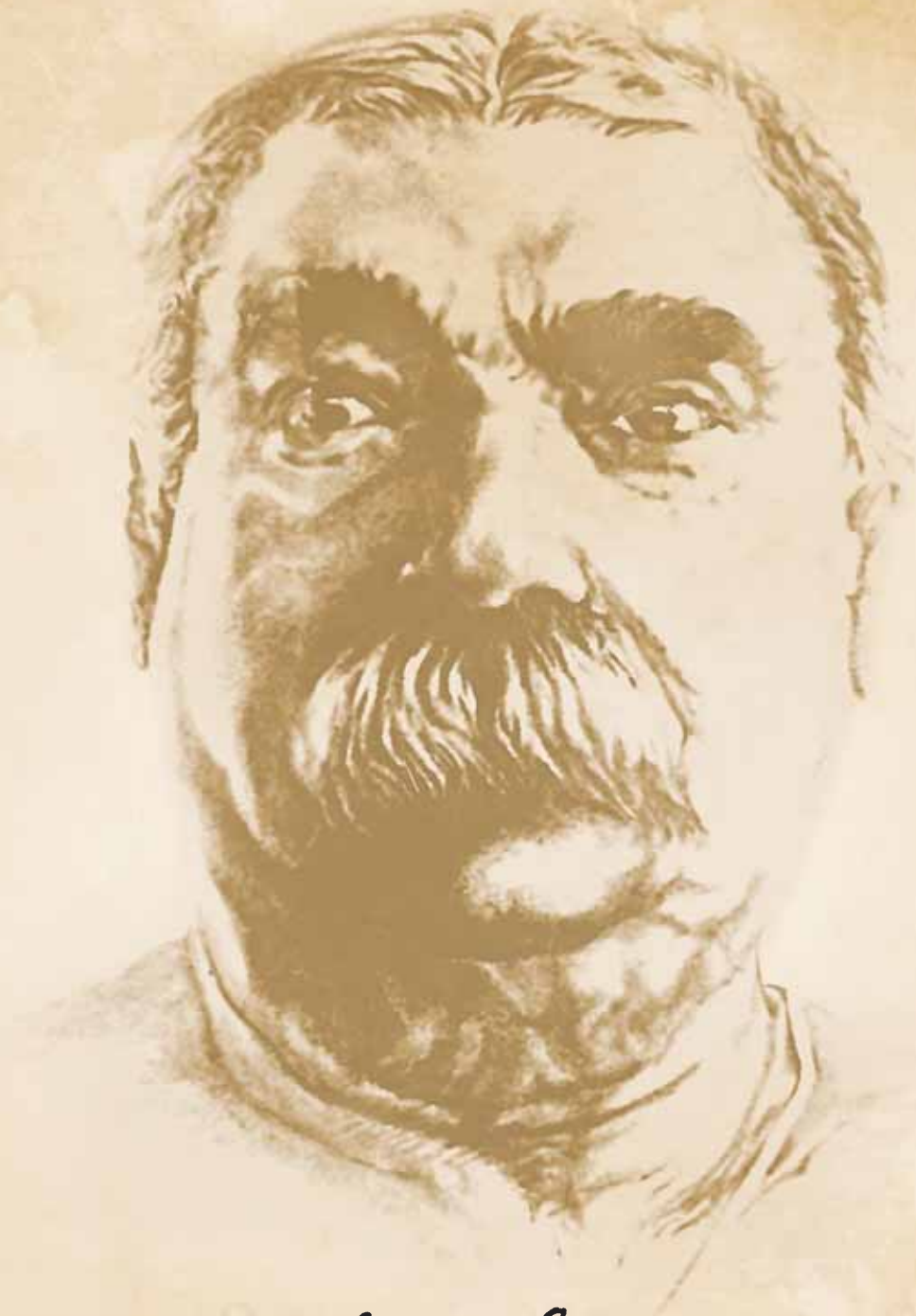

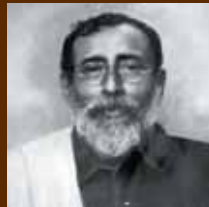
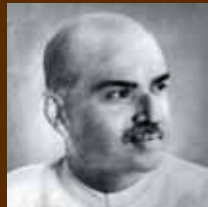

1915

Permission sought for establishing a College in South Calcutta under the leadership of eminent mathematician, educationist, Vice Chancellor (Calcutta University), Chief Justice (Calcutta High Court) Sir Asutosh Mookerjee.

Approval from the Govt. of India to upgrade South Suburban School into an intermediate College.

1916

3 June, 1916 — College named South Suburban College and Sir Asutosh elected President of its Governing Body.

17 July, 1916 — The College started to function formally, from 26, Lansdowne Road, Calcutta.

1917

The College shifted to Bijni House, 157, Russa Road, Calcutta (later demolished for constructing the Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute).

1918

Intermediate College upgraded to Degree College.

1924

Sir Asutosh passed away on 25 May. South Suburban College renamed ASUTOSH COLLEGE on 15 June.

1925

Teaching of Science subjects started.

1929

The Asutosh Mookerjee Memorial Institute, founded in 1927, appealed to the Calcutta Corporation (the then Mayor was Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose) for a portion of land from Hazra Park (Jatin Das Park) to be leased to the institute for the construction of a new building for Asutosh College, a Library and an Auditorium.

1932

Asutosh College (Morning section) opened and subsequently renamed as Asutosh College for Women in 1948, and Jogamaya Devi College in 1958.

1934

Dr. Syamaprasad Mookerjee took over as President of the Governing Body and served the College in this capacity till his death.

1935

Asutosh College shifted to the newly constructed building under the initiative of Dr. Syamaprasad Mookerjee, that exists to this day as the Main Building.

1945

Evening Department of Commerce opened and renamed Syamaprasad College in 1958.

OUR CAMPUS

Main Building

The main building of the college is located on 92 S. P. Mookerjee Road, adjacent to the lush green Jatin Das Park. Proximity to the park makes the classrooms bright and airy.



Annexe Building

Constructed during the Platinum Jubilee Year of the college in 1991, it is located across Basanta Bose Road which runs along the north face of the College, and houses the Asutosh College Training Centre (ACTC), the reading section of the Central Library and some newly-introduced Departments.



Centenary Building

Located at 22, Kalighat Road, it was inaugurated on 1 April, 2015, to mark the College Centenary. It has a modern seminar hall along with conference room, e-library, instrumentation centre, smart class room make the teaching-learning process more technologically-enabled.



Humanities Block

This four-storied building at 16 Basanta Bose Road housing some of the Humanities Departments, was inaugurated in the Centenary year of the college.



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Second Campus (Green)

Located in Bhasa, near Joka, on 11 acres of prime land on Diamond Harbour Road is the second campus of the college. When complete, it will have a 2.5 acres water-body landscaped into the architectural design for serenity and a pollution-free, eco-friendly 'green campus' tranquility.

A state-of-the-art Academic-cum-Administrative building, Central Library and high-tech Laboratories, Auditoria, Students' Hostels and a residential complex for members of the teaching and non-teaching staff will complete our conception of the new campus.

This campus has already been surrounded by a high boundary wall of 4000 running ft., followed by the planting of 400 saplings. 'Sushrut', the medicinal plants garden with its collection of more than a 100

types of plants, is a major attraction in this campus. It also has an orchidarium and a Butterfly garden. The construction work of the Office building and the Hostel buildings for boys and girls has been completed with UGC funding and that of the Academic building is in progress. The academic activities in the campus will be distributed across the proposed Schools of Life Sciences, Earth Sciences, Physical Sciences, Social Sciences, Computer Science and Technology, Rural Sciences, Distance Education, Language & Literature, etc., for interdisciplinary studies and research. Activities currently being undertaken here include Aquaculture, Organic Farming, Rainwater Harvesting and Biogas Generation. There is a badminton court and a volleyball ground for students and boarders.

Students' Common Room

Students' Health Home

Facilities of Students' Health Home are available to the students. Safety Policy for students has been ensured.

Students' Union

Like all colleges administered according to the Calcutta University Statute, Asutosh College has a democratically elected Students' Union. There is a constructive relation between the Union and the administration. The general atmosphere of the college is conducive to serious academics. Critical inputs are welcomed from the Students' Union, and the Union and the administration co-operate to ensure discipline. 'Canvas', the College Magazine, is published annually by the Students' Union.

Students' Hostels

Asutosh College is one of the few colleges in South Kolkata which has hostel facilities. However, the available seats are insufficient to meet the needs of all intending boarders. Seats are allotted on a strict merit-cum-distance basis. The Girls' and Boys'

Hostels, constructed with UGC funds, are located in the second campus.



Games

The College has a tent and ground at Kolkata Maidan. It is only one of two colleges in Kolkata which has this facility. There is also a Gymnasium and Yoga Centre in the Annexe Building (ACTC).

The College football, cricket and rowing teams have won awards at various tournaments and competitions. Annual sports and a cricket match between teaching and non-teaching staff are regular calendar events. Champions among participants are given free studentship.





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STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES



In recent years we have had the opportunity of having distinguished sports alumni of our college – Late Chuni Goswami, Sri Sukumar Samajpati and Sri Manas Bhattacharya – at the Annual College Sports.

Placement Cell

The College has an active Placement Cell which is looked after by Dr. Dhiman Dutta, Department of Statistics and Dr. Pooja Chatterjee, Department of Psychology. Its goal is to facilitate employment



opportunities for every willing student on completion of her/his academic curriculum. Significant progress has been made in this regard. Reputed Indian and multinational companies regularly visit the campus and select a large number of students for recruitment.

The college has recently introduced **two new units** to address the needs of students in a job-oriented socio-economic set-up.

- The **Career Counselling and Training Programme (CCTP)**, currently being coordinated by **Dr. Chandramalli Sengupta**, mentored by **Dr. Sajal Bhattacharya**, under the advice of the **Vice-Principal, Prof. Apurba Ray**, and the **Bursar, Dr. Manas Kabi**, is a comprehensive **6 months' Training Schedule** designed to give final year undergraduate students of the college an idea of the various career options in each subject, offer guidance for Competitive Examinations, impart practical training on professional etiquette and also provide cognitive analysis of individual interest. Mainly conducted by a team of faculty members drawn from the various Departments of the College, resource persons from outside the college with expertise in relevant fields are also invited to impart training.

According to their core subject of study, students are divided into 7 groups. The Programme is divided into 4 phases:

- **Phase 1- Orientation**
- **Phase 2 - Generic-Specific Counselling**
- **Phase 3 - Practical & Interactive Ability Training**
- **Phase 4 - Evaluation**

Evaluation is through Gradation System as per CU Guidelines. After successful completion of the programme each student will receive a Certificate from the College.

- The **Soft Skills Development Unit** has been set up to equip students with skills that will help them to make the transition from the campus to the corporate world. It has two sections, a **Computer**

Training unit, and a **Communication and Soft Skills Development** unit.

The **Computer Training** unit is coordinated by **Sri Arnab Kumar Ghoshal**, Assistant Professor of Computer Science, with **Smt. Mithu Bhattacharya** as Asstt. Coordinator. Students are given training in **basic computer operations** and **web designing**. The programme, of 6 months duration, is meant for students of the 1st Semester (UG).

The **Communication and Soft Skills Development** programme is designed to train students of the Undergraduate 3rd Semester in Business Etiquette, Time and Stress Management, develop teamwork and inter-personal skills, and help build leadership qualities. Activities include practice of listening with the help of YouTube and Bluetooth speakers, public speaking exercises like extempore talks and group discussion, team working sessions, and time management exercises.

The unit is mentored by **Smt. Sanchita Bhattacharya**, of the Communicative English department, and coordinated by **Dr. Rimjhim Ray**, of the Psychology department.

Reservation

Seats for admission are reserved for SC, ST, OBC and Physically Challenged candidates according to government regulations.

Concession

Tuition Fees concession may be available to meritorious students coming from economically backward families.

Asutosh College Training Centre (ACTC)

The Asutosh College Training Centre was developed in the Platinum Jubilee year of the College (1991) to equip students for job-screening examinations like WBCS, SSC, SET, NET, etc. Currently, it offers short-term training courses in **Industrial Safety** and **Computers/Computer Applications** and for **NET/SET, WBCS, SSC** and **Combined Examinations**. It also offers **One-Year Postgraduate Diploma Courses**

(under Netaji Subhas Open University) in **Disaster Risk Management, Export-Import Management and Travel and Tourism Management**.

NSS and NCC

In order to integrate academics with social responsibility the College has reactivated its **National Social Service (NSS)** and **National Cadet Corps (NCC)** Units after the lapse of more than a decade.

The NCC Unit is affiliated to the 20 Bengal Battalion of the Indian Army. The process of recruitment of cadets, both girls and boys begins after the commencement of a new academic session.

The **Adventure Club** for students, steered by **Dr. Dilruba Khatoun (Economics)** and **Prof. Soumen**



Das (Sociology) with assistance from **Sri Murari Chakraborty (NTS, second Campus)** and under the guidance of **Dr. Paromita Chaudhuri (English)**, functions under the aegis of the NCC unit. The club arranges **Nature and Adventure Sports Camps** for its members despite a busy academic schedule. In previous years, camps have been organised in **Sirkabad, near Arsha**, and in **Duarsini, close to Mathaburu**, both in Purulia district. Typical activities



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in these camps include trekking, rock climbing, orienteering, stargazing, bird-watching, and stream crossing.

The NCC unit also conducts self-defence classes for girls students in collaboration with Kolkata Police under their Project Sukanya Scheme.

Remedial Coaching

UGC-sponsored free remedial coaching for SC/ST/OBC/Minority students are held in each Department.

Free Coaching for entry in Service

UGC sponsored free coaching for SC/ST/OBC/Minority students are arranged for WBCS,SSC,NET & SET examinations as and when required.



Alumni Association

The College has a very rich and distinguished alumni, who extend support at various levels. In 2010, the Alumni Association was officially registered and the first Annual Alumni Meet was organised in 2011.

Photocopy Centre

Photocopying facilities are provided to the students at a subsidised rate. This centre is located in the ground floor of the ACTC.

Grievance Redressal Cell

The College has a Disciplinary Committee, an Anti-Ragging Committee and the Committee to probe complaints of Sexual Harassment of Women. There is a complaint box on the ground floor near the entrance to receive in writing the grievances of students.

Cheap Store

Books, pen, writing sheets and other stationery are available during College hours from the cheap store on the ground floor of the Main Building.

Cheap Canteen

There is also a food corner. Students may have their lunch or tiffin at a subsidised price.

Other facilities

Other student-oriented facilities, include the **Anti-Ragging Cell** and **ICC** (Internal Complaints Committee), a **Psychotherapy Unit** (Under the Dept. of Psychology), a **Yoga Unit** (under the supervision of Dr. Manas Kabi, Dept. of Bengali), **Eco Club** (under the Dept. of Environmental Science), and a **Women Empowerment Cell** steered by Dr. Rina Kar Dutta (Philosophy) and assisted by Sk. Mohiudin (Computer Science) which implements the **Kanyashree Project** and the **Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum- Means Scholarship** in the College. There is also a **Health**



Care Unit managed by a trained nurse under the charge of the Biochemistry Department.

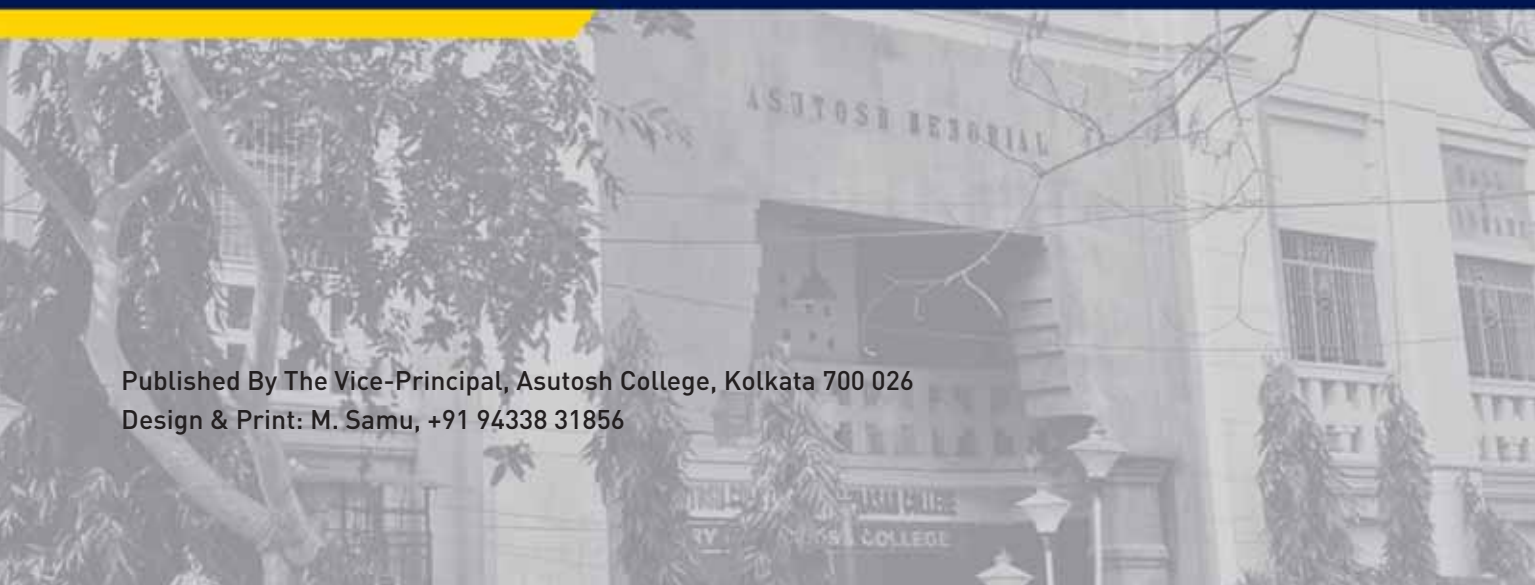
RULES & REGULATIONS
